Target Groups

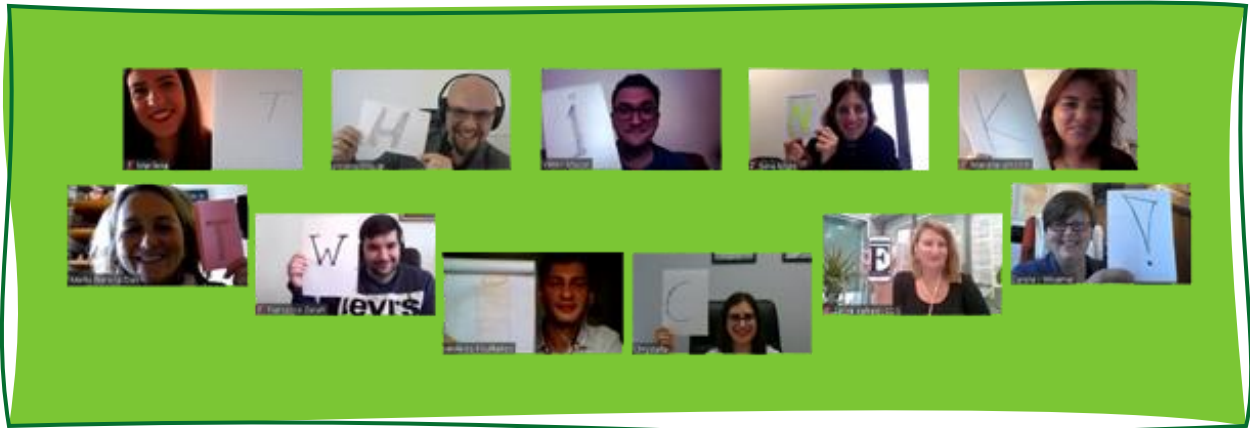
- Experienced & new project managers working or willing to work in EU funded projects & in project-based organisations;

The Treasury will inspire you to find solutions within your own organisation and provide you with enough information for you to make conscious decisions.
- **Stress Test of current practice leading to a personalised Learning Pathway.**
Based on the contents of the Treasury, an interactive Stress Test “How green is the management of my project?” will be developed to test the ecological sustainability of your own project management.



1st Transnational Meeting



The project partners successfully carried out the 1st Transnational Meeting on 19th & 20th November 2020.

Due to the pandemic restrictions, the meeting could not take place at Wisamar in Leipzig, Germany, so it was conducted online, and the partners tried to make the most of it. Once we got to know each other better and all management related issues were processed, partners discussed the background and the objectives of the project. We agreed that much of our current practice in project management could be improved and made more environmentally friendly and sustainable. The preliminary work on the intellectual outputs included:

- **IO1** – Curated Treasury of good practice in ecologically sustainable project management: first ideas, methods and tools related to ecological sustainability already in place within the partner organisations.
- **IO2** – Stress Test of current practice leading to a personalized Learning Pathway: the first ideas and future aims.

A project timeline was agreed, and everyone got to work straight away.
