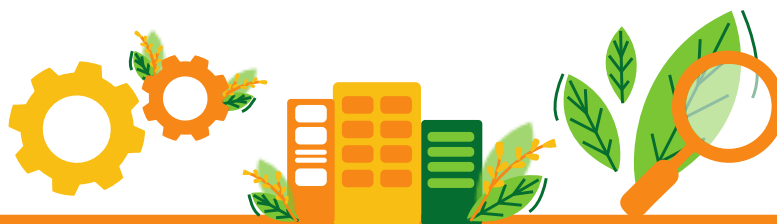

 **Our Treasury of good practices in project management is on air!** 

How can I make my organization ecologically sustainable? Are there green alternatives on what I implement? Is it possible to organize my events on an environmentally friendly way? Do my digital activities have an impact on the environment? These and many more questions on an environmentally friendly project management, answered on Think Twice Treasury of good practices!

Think Twice team gathered many practices and knowledge form around the world, that can help a project manager act greener. After scrutiny search, partnership, gathered 59 green practices that can be used on 4 main phases of project management.

- Management (work environment, management processes, collaboration with partners etc.)
- Implementation (how to do everyday tasks independently or in collaboration with partners)
- Dissemination (how to get through your message, how to disseminate your results etc.)
- Evaluation (quality assurance, risk management, planning exploitation of project outputs etc.)



We spread and tested it!

During last September and October, we tried to promote Think Twice! and give a glimpse of our treasury to the world! All partners showed our treasury and the next steps of the project to their network through online and physical events. Below, you can take a look at what happened in each project country.





UK, 19th of October



The UK Event was held on 19th October 2021. It was held at a sustainably run co-working space called Crabtree Hall and then the social part was at the attached café The Nest, which also adheres to various sustainable practices like sourcing locally, using leftover food to feed animals, recycling and using reusable kitchenware.

The participants were representatives of North Yorkshire based NGOs and businesses interested in developing their own sustainability.



Cyprus, 28th of September

During the event, useful good practices on "green" project management were discussed and interactive and constructive exchange of views were built on this topic. Slovenia, 28th of September

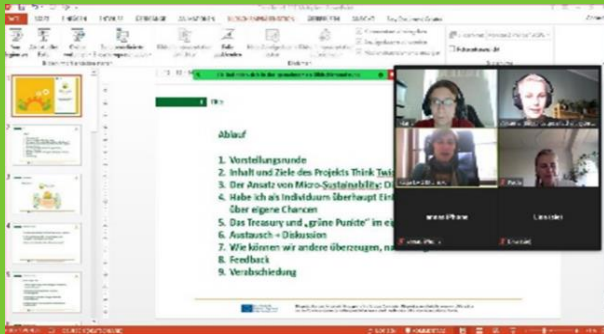

Germany, 30th of September



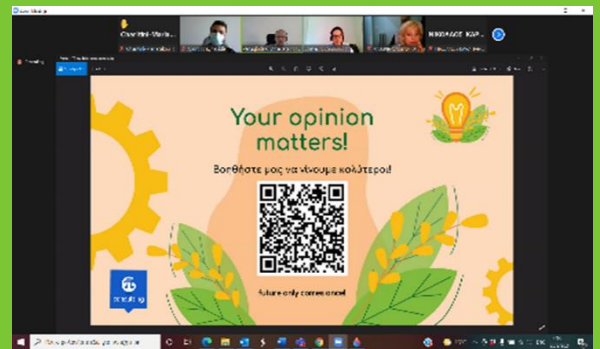
In Germany, an online workshop took place on 30th of September. During the event, it was explored how our management activities have an impact on the environment and what we can do from now on.



Greece, 23rd of September



We had an online event on 23rd of September. We focused on exploring green management, with the help of an expert, and had great discussion on our treasury with the participants. Participants were very active through the event, and we had a great discussion on the protection of the environment in Greek society.



Spain, 23rd of September



We held a physical event on 23rd of September. We presented the Think Twice project and then the participants worked on the evaluation of the Curated Treasury, through a non-formal educational activity.

During the multiplier event, participants, divided into 4 groups (one per phase) after selecting 5 GPs each, have drawn up a ranking of the 3 most significant practices according to their point of view.





Portugal, 27th of September



On September 27, 2021, the Portuguese partner University of Aveiro conducted the project's ThinkTwice! multiplier event. The event was conducted both in online and face to face model, gathering online and presential participants The event's agenda included the presentation of the project by Professor Marlene Amorim (from Aveiro University), and a presentation and debate with an invited speaker - the president of APOGEP – Portuguese Association of Project Management.



Italy, 25th of September



“The 25th of September took place the Think Twice! Event in Cori. 31 people representing mainly local association and businesses took part to the event during which the Curated Treasury have been presented. During the event feedback have been gathered and the audience have been informed about the next steps.”
